

Hawaii students nationally recognized for wildfire education efforts in wake of Lahaina disaster








Leihōkū Wildfire Mitigation Demonstration Project

Initial clearing of grass, brush, and kiawe branches will be performed by **Kuahiwi Fencing and Wildlife Services**. Mahalo to **Dept. of Hawaiian Home Lands** for Right of Entry Permit and **Hawaiian Electric** for funding for this important project. **Leihōkū Elementary** students will develop ideas to keep the area free of fuel for wildfires.



The firebreak will extend for 1,000 ft x 30 ft between Pu'u Mā'ili'ili and the school.
